## Demolition of Buildings at 155 and 157 Stephenson Avenue

June 2020

Dear Resident,

We are writing to provide an update on Hydro One's Main Transformer Station refurbishment project. As you may recall, Hydro One will be upgrading and modernizing equipment that has reached its end-of-life at our Main Transformer Station and expanding the station's footprint, as shown on the reverse map, in order to ensure we continue to deliver a safe and reliable supply of power.

Activities to prepare for construction began in late-2019, and in the upcoming weeks, we will be removing the buildings located at 155 and 157 Stephenson Avenue. This demolition work is anticipated to take two weeks.

While this work is being completed, residents may notice an increase in noise, vehicle traffic and dust. Additionally, a temporary closure of the south sidewalk directly located in front of the station will be required. Access to Main Street will be maintained, with pedestrian foot traffic rerouted to the north sidewalk.

Following this preparatory work, construction at the transformer station will begin in the Fall of this year.

As we continue to follow the latest developments related to COVID-19, we are guided by our commitment to protect employees and contractors, and our need to maintain the safe and reliable supply of electricity. We have ensured all staff and contractors are equipped to complete their activities while taking precautions including following good hygiene and social distancing, whenever possible.
